ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Key Result #1** – Initiate and oversee relief program assessments
- **Key Result #2** – Oversee design of new relief programs in coordination with Director of Relief and field relief staff, and seek adequate funding sources
- **Key Result #3** – Oversee the implementation of all relief programs in a specific field, including: ensure adequate documentation and reporting; manage human resources; manage finances; provide spiritual leadership
- **Key Result #4** – Monitor and evaluate relief programs
- **Key Result #5** – Represent FH in relief field and liaise with HQ
- Other duties may be assigned

QUALIFICATIONS

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty/function satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. - Has a vibrant personal relationship with Jesus Christ, commitment to Food for the Hungry's Vision of a Community, agreement with mission and desire to actively participate in group devotions.
- Appropriate academic and experiential technical background.
- Strong relational and team-building skills.
- Highly organized, able to multi-task and manage priorities.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills; proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite.
- Physical requirements: Ability to sit at a computer for 8 hours a day doing repetitive motions on a keyboard; ability to lift 25 pounds above shoulder height consistently; ability to stand for long periods, walking over rough, uneven or rocky surfaces at times.
- Ability to travel domestically and internationally up to 25% of time per year.

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE

Bachelor's degree (B. A.) from accredited four-year college or university in related field; three to five years field experience in supervisory capacity; or equivalent combination of education and experience. Masters strongly preferred.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES

Supervises all relief staff in a specific country.
